

Crochet Flowers for Vulval Cancer and VIN

Vulval cancer is a very uncommon cancer and there is no national screening process for it. Making women aware of the symptoms is important. Honouring those who are diagnosed and raising the profile is the aim of Crochet Flowers for Vulval Cancer and VIN (VIN - Vulval Intraepithelial Neoplasia are abnormal pre-cancer cells in the skin of the vulva.)
